Philly, Allentown doctors top in the state! **Anna Doubeni, MD; Mary Fabian, MD ‘Family Physicians of the Year’**

(HARRISBURG, PA. Feb. 28, 2017) This year, Pennsylvania’s top doctors are from Allentown and Philadelphia! **The Pennsylvania Academy of Family Physicians (PAFP)** has chosen **Anna Doubeni, MD of Philadelphia** and **Mary Fabian, MD of Allentown** as its **2017 Family Physicians of the Year**. For the first time, the PAFP is co-awarding two excellent physicians on their accomplishments. Drs. Doubeni and Fabian will be presented with their awards at the 2017 PAFP Annual Business Meeting, beginning at 6 p.m. on Friday, March 17, at the Hilton Harrisburg in Harrisburg, Pennsylvania.

Dr. Doubeni practices with Penn Family Care in West Philadelphia, while also teaching at the University of Pennsylvania. She is the lead physician for Priority Access, a program which assists patients with frequent emergency room utilization, and lead physician for the Penn Family Care home visit program. She is the director of population health management for the Department of Family Medicine and Community Health at the University of Pennsylvania’s Perelman School of Medicine.

Dr. Fabian practices with St. Luke’s Physician Group in Allentown. Fabian holds a special interest in research issues involving woman’s health care and patient education in preventive care in women’s health, tobacco cessation programs, and opiate awareness. She is involved in the Brandywine Heights Drug Task Force and Kutztown Strong as the school physician to these groups.
