## Lancaster doctor wins Public Health Award

*(HARRISBURG, PA. Feb. 21, 2020)* Lancaster physician Jeffrey Martin, MD has been named the Pennsylvania Academy of Family Physicians' 2020 Public Health Award winner!

Martin, Chair of the Department of Family and Community Medicine at Penn Medicine Lancaster General, began his medical career at the University of Colorado School of Medicine in Denver, Colorado. He completed his residency training in family medicine at the Lancaster General Hospital Family Practice Residency Program in Lancaster.

He serves on various committees, including the Medical Executive Committee and the Family and Community Medicine Education Committee at Lancaster General Hospital, and in his community as the Medical Director of IU-13 in Lancaster County and the founder of Lancaster Lead Coalition, a stakeholder group focused on eradicating lead poisoning in children in Lancaster County.

A longtime champion of public health causes, colleagues praise him for his leadership and dedication to the health of individuals and communities alike.
