Broad scope of practice, volume of visits, diverse populations served in community clinics, nursing homes, hospital settings. Investment in Family Medicine Residencies effectively expands the workforce pipeline for primary care in Pennsylvania while having an immediate impact on services provided within residency training as demonstrated below.
