## York Doctor Named Top Physician Teacher!

### Dr. Gordon Zubrod named “Exemplary Teacher of the Year”

*(HARRISBURG, PA.)* This year, Pennsylvania’s top physician teacher is from York! **The Pennsylvania Academy of Family Physicians (PAFP)** has chosen **Dr. Gordon Zubrod of York** as its **2013 Exemplary Teacher of the Year**. Dr. Zubrod is the assistant residency program director at the York Hospital Family Medicine Residency.

Zubrod graduated summa cum laude with honors in history from the Pennsylvania State University and attended medical school at the Pennsylvania State College of Medicine. He completed his family medicine residency at Naval Hospital Camp Pendleton. A long thread of international medicine experience runs through Zubrod’s career, including a medical mission trip and research on indigenous healers in Uganda, East Africa; community medicine rotations in Uzbekistan and Kazakhstan; short-term medical relief projects in the Philippines, Mexico and Haiti; an academic teaching trip to Kurdistan; and international medicine leadership training in Mexico.

Zubrod’s colleagues praise him for his commitment to medicine and compassion for patients. “He is able to meet [patients] at the root of their humanity with self-effacement and self-donation,” said Dr. Andre Lijoi, associate director of the York Hospital Family Medicine Residency. “His integrity is impeccable and his enthusiasm to serve those overlooked by others virtuous.”
