- Avoid using race as a proxy for biology or genetics Ex: 35 yr old male with sickle cell disease INSTEAD OF 35 yr. old African American with sickle cell disease. ALSO when presenting treatment algorithms DO NOT present race-based guidelines and measurements;
- Highlight the impact(s) of systems/structures when possible to avoid victim blaming Do not consider health
 condition as a personal or moral failure Persons of color are NOT experiencing Covid at higher rates due to
 their poor hygiene (look for the systemic cause)
- Please include one learner objective relative to social determinants of health for your topic.
