

SAFETY PRECAUTIONS IN PLACE FOR SUN, SAND AND CME CONFERENCE

Your safety is our #1 priority. This list may be adjusted prior to your arrival to ensure all guidelines are being followed to the letter.

Please refrain from attending the conference if you are not feeling well or may have been exposed to someone who is known to have COVID-19 within the past 14 days. Likewise, do not attend if you believe that you may have been exposed to a confirmed or suspected case of COVID19 or have been diagnosed with COVID-19 and are not yet cleared as non-contagious by your health care provider or team.

- Temperature checks will take place upon arrival at hotel check-in;
Note, it is the hotel policy that if you have a temperature above 100.4, you will be asked to leave.
- If you have COVID symptoms at any time while you are on property, you will be asked to leave.
- Plexiglass is in place at hotel registration and hostess stand in dining room.
- Floor decals noting 6 foot distance are in place.
- There are hand sanitizer stations throughout the property, including meeting rooms. There will be wipes also.
- Room sets will follow appropriate spacing guidelines.
- Masks must be worn at all times inside (unless seated at a dining table).
- Hourly cleaning of common areas
- There are reserved time slots for the indoor pool & fitness center.
- Rooms are fogged after check-out before next guest checks in.
- Maid service will not be offered during your stay unless specifically requested by the guest with the front desk.
- Your registration information will be emailed to you. Badges, if not mailed to you, will be available onsite and given to you at hotel check-in.
- The onsite registration area will be staffed and stanchions will be available to control flow of foot traffic.
- Please no handshakes.
- Any food handling/serving will be done by hotel staff with appropriate face and hand coverings. If there is a buffet during the event, you will not be able to handle serving utensils or plates, these will all be done by hotel staff.
- Grab-n-go options will be available for most food /beverage functions and will be set up appropriately to allow for distancing.
